Supply List for chenille class

Sewing machine in good working order with walking foot if possible

Safety pins (a lot)

Batting

4 panels that are the same

backing fabric the size you want your finished product to be (if making it bigger than the panel otherwise the size of your panel) I did mine panel width and 18 inches top and bottom will also need enough fabric to bind when done having non directional fabric if possible

machine quilting gloves make handling the quilting easier

chenille cutter I like the olfa cutter

sharp pointed scissors

thread to match the panel you will probably use at least 4 bobbins of thread or more so you may want to wind your bobbins ahead of time

marking pencil that you can see on your panel

rotary cutting supplies
